What You Need to Know

REGISTRATION

- **CHECK-IN:** Camp begins on Sunday afternoon, registration is open from 3-5 PM. Dinner is at 5:30 PM
- **CHECK OUT:** Camp ends the following Saturday after breakfast. Check-out is at 10 am. Guests are asked to check out at the registration office to return keys and complete payments.
- **PRE-REGISTRATION FOR 2026:** Guests will have the opportunity to pre-register for next year at the end of the week. More details will be available at the Registration office.

CHAPEL & KID'S MINISTRY

Children's Programming is available daily, Monday - Friday during chapel times for ages 0 through 11 years.

Junior Youth Programming is available Monday through Friday for ages 12-15 years.

Adult Chapels are daily, Monday through Friday, morning and evening sessions.

WATER ACTIVITIES

Tubing/Waterski tickets are for sale daily

Guests bringing motorboats must complete a boat registration form.

- All boats must launch at the public boat launch at the south end of Faraday Lake. Access from Monck Road off of Highway 28 South.
- Guest boats may dock at JOY's dock, if space is available, or anchor on the opposite side of the dock from the swimming area.

MEALS

Meal times are at 8:30 AM, 12:30 PM and 5:30 PM daily

Please let our office know if you have dietary restrictions before your arrival

Trailer park guests may purchase a meal plan or individual meals during their stay. Our team appreciates 24 hrs' notice before meal time of your booking.

Take-out meals are available.

Tuck Shop

The Tuck Shop is open in the afternoon and the evening.

All JOY merch will be available for purchase daily. Guests are asked to make a deposit in their JOY Store Account online or at check-in to use during their stay. Joy Bible Camp NO LONGER allows guests to run open tabs.

Parents/guardians are responsible for the purchases made by the children in their care. Any funds remaining on a guest's camp store account at the end of the week are available for a refund, can be turned into a voucher to be used toward future JOY registrations or tuck accounts, or may be transferred to a donation, at your request. Refunds will not be issued at check-out.

Is the Water Drinkable?

The water from all the tapes at JOY is clean, fresh well water, that is regularly tested and treated.

What can go in the recycling?

Where do I park?

We have 3 parking lots - in front of the main building, beside Aspen, and behind the Lakeside/Hillside. Please do not park in the laneway in front of the motels or right beside the main building, both are fire routes. Please also do not block in other cars.

When is the main building open?

7 am -11 pm.

Where can I buy JOY merch?

The retail store will be open daily during your stay.

How do I donate?

You can donate at our main office. We take cash, cheque, and credit/debit. You can also make regular donations online through our website or by filling out a donation slip at the main office. All donations help change lives at JOY.
